

Personal Motor Vehicle Import License

Qualifying Conditions:

Before importing a used motor vehicle, you must first apply for an Import Licence. The Import Licence will be issued based on the applicant meeting the following conditions:

- ✓ Hybrid Vehicles - 5 years from the year of manufacture and Euro 4 compliant
- ✓ Diesel, Petrol, LPG, CNG vehicles – Euro 4 compliant

Application Requirements:

To obtain the Import Licence you must submit the following documents:

- ✓ Application letter
- ✓ Deregistration documents or Export Certificates of the motor vehicle
- ✓ Applicants ID
- ✓ JEVIC report (for Japan, Australia and New Zealand imports)
- ✓ Certificate of Compliance to Euro 4 standards if JEVIC is not available in the country of importation

The application can be dropped off at FRCS, Building 3 Level 4 with the Tariff and Trade Team or emailed to tariff&trade@frcs.org.fj. This is no application fee for this service.

Important Points:

- ✓ Brand New vehicles do not require import licence
- ✓ Import Licence is to be obtained before the vehicle is shipped into the country
- ✓ JEVIC Inspection is required by LTA when vehicles are imported from Japan, Australia and New Zealand
- ✓ Left Hand Drive vehicles are prohibited unless prior approved by LTA.
- ✓ Written-off vehicles are prohibited

JEVIC Inspection:

LTA requires all used motor vehicles imported from Japan, Australia and New Zealand to undergo JEVIC Inspection. For a booking, you can contact the following:
